Programme outline
The programme covers practical trade skills (with underpinning theory) in the following:

- use and maintenance of carpentry tools and equipment including hand tools, portable power tools, machine tools
- erecting profiles, setting out and levelling houses exercises
- sub-floor flooring
- erecting frames and trusses
- erecting ceilings
- construction of framework as required
- site safe certificate
- first aid
- health and safety

Course materials
Students will need their own set of tools, including builder's apron, steel cap boots, cutting knife (with snap blade), nail punch set, folding rule, 8m measuring tape, combination square, claw hammer, chisel set, carpenter's pencil, small padlock, screwdrivers, calculator, pen and paper. A smartphone or tablet is also required to access online learning resources.

Class times for semester one and two are Monday to Thursday, 9am to 3pm.

Depending on what you own before starting the course, additional costs may be up to \$600- \$700 (approx). Assistance with personal equipment is available through WINZ under Course Related Costs.
